**12th January 2027 – Joe Houghton: ‘Processing in Mono’ (via Zoom)**

This is a club night with a difference. Joe will discuss the different approaches and thought processes needed to both shoot and post-process your images in black & white. We will send Joe two folders of images. One has members’ unprocessed RAW files, the other their processed images. Joe edits the RAW files using Lightroom & Nik Silver Efex, and shows his own approach to editing the file to club standard, then we compare Joe’s edit with the member’s edit and discuss the differences.
